Para No.	Issue	Action taken
8	Chairperson shared the experience of the recent visit of the Commission to Nagaland and Mizoram. Chairperson mentioned that for the development of Scheduled Tribes, a number of steps were needed to be taken and, in particular, emphasized on the following areas:-	160 number of projects at an estimated cost of Rs. 1553.57 crore has been sanctioned under NLCPR Scheme for the Nagaland State.
8(i)	At present, there is no Medical College and Nursing College in Kohima. Thus, there is a need for setting up of a Medical Colleges and Nursing Colleges in Kohima and also in other parts of the North East Region.	<p>Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India has informed that State Govt. had proposed setting up of a medical college which can make use of part of the infrastructure and skilled manpower available with CIHSR, with an estimated cost of Rs. 402 crore. The proposal is pending with the M/o Health & Family Welfare.</p> <p>A new scheme relating to establishment of new medical colleges attached to upgraded district hospitals in the country has been approved by CCEA. After finalization of this scheme, the funds will be allocated for establishment of the college. As the State of Nagaland has no medical college, priority will be given to the State for establishment of the college in the State.</p> <p><u>Action Taken by NEC:</u> The NEC has funded 10 Medical and Health projects in Nagaland which are ongoing at an approved cost of Rs. 8624.47 Lakhs and an amount of Rs. 2652.04 has been released as on 11th July 2014 and the State has utilized an amount of Rs 1410.00 lakhs. The list of projects is in Annexure.</p>
